

In-Vehicle Signage Set

v1.1: signs became purchased decals. v1.2: driver ID became a worn badge. v1.3: complaint-procedure handouts removed; the posted card with a phone number is the complaint procedure. Owner rulings 2026-08-26.

The signage system: buy two things, print two things

Cabin rule signs are stickers, not paper. Passengers see them on the glass; inspectors check that they are there and permanent. Company and driver identification are paper you print from this pack.

YOU BUY (page 2, picks in DOC-3 item 13)

- "ALL PASSENGERS MUST WEAR SEAT BELTS" window decal, one or more per vehicle
- "NO SMOKING, EATING, OR DRINKING" window decal, one or more per vehicle

YOU PRINT (page 3)

- Provider info card for the cabin: company name, phone, email
- Driver photo ID badges (template, page 3): worn during service, presented on request. A badge travels with the driver and is always current; a printed dashboard card is stale the day drivers rotate

Mounting rules (all signage)

- Permanent mounting only. Tape falls down and fails inspection; decals adhere to glass or hard panel.
- Exterior lettering is separate and bigger: provider name, phone, and vehicle number on both front doors, permanent vinyl, letters 3 inches or taller in contrasting color. Magnetic signs are not permitted.
- Confidentiality rule, every jurisdiction: nothing on or in the vehicle may indicate that passengers are medical-program members. That includes the business name itself.
- Where required, operating-authority information (for example WMATC) is displayed as well.

Where decals go

Visible from every passenger seat: one set near the passenger entry, one mid-cabin (window glass or hard panel). Interior-facing, clean surface, pressed flat. Replace any decal that peels, fades, or scratches; a decal you cannot read is a decal you do not have.

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Decal spec: what to buy

Any decal passes if it meets this spec: exact required wording, permanent-adhesive vinyl, waterproof and UV-stable, readable from passenger seats. Minimum size 2 x 4 inches; on full-size vans prefer 4 x 4.5 inches. The picks below were checked live on 2026-08-26.

ALL PASSENGERS MUST WEAR SEAT BELTS

PICK: [YIKIADA "Seat Belts Must Be Worn" vinyl decals, 2 x 4 in, 10-pack](#)

Ten decals covers a small fleet with spares. Larger alternative for full-size vans: "Seat Belt Stickers 10 Pack, Must Be Worn" at 4 x 4.5 in. Wording variants like "Seat belts must be worn in this vehicle" satisfy the same line.

NO SMOKING, EATING, OR DRINKING

PICK: [Meitaat "No Smoking No Eating No Drinking" vinyl decals, 2 x 4 in, 10-pack](#)

(Amazon search)

Same size family as the seat-belt decal for a consistent look. Larger alternative for vans: 7 x 10 in OSHA-style vinyl label. Buy the same brand family for both messages when you can; matched decals read as a managed fleet.

Fleet tip: one purchase covers every vehicle. Put two spare decals of each kind in the glove-box packet; a scratched decal gets replaced on the spot, not at the next inspection.

Trim nothing, print nothing on this page: these are purchased items. Inspection checks presence, wording, and condition.

Standard credential size (3.375 x 2.125 in), two per sheet. Print on cardstock, affix the driver photo, laminate or slide into a badge holder, wear on a lanyard or clip during service. Presented on request at inspections and by members.
